Annotation:

The proficient exemplar makes a clear thesis statement about the influence of external and internal forces on the main character and then goes on to develop the idea with multiple examples from the novel *Walk Two Moons*. The supporting evidence is presented as details from the plot, but without the necessary commentary to show how the details relate to the thesis. The structure shows an understanding of the importance of the topic sentences relating to the thesis, but from then on the organization within the paragraphs, as evidenced by the transitions, such as the repetition of "when," the use of "after" and "next," reflects an emphasis on a retelling of the plot. Some of the evidence, such as the detail about the fireplace, seems disconnected from the thesis. The introduction and conclusion are adequate. Command of conventions is adequate, though the exemplar could show stronger command of and variety in sentence structure. Overall, this is a mid-range proficient exemplar.
