The main features that have changed throughout the years are:

- mobility: the oldest phone did not have the capabilities to go from place to place
- Size: as phone became more mobile sizes of phones have decreased
- Dials: The transition from rotary phones (the ones that had the dials that spun), to buttons, and now most common being the touch screen

Let's take a look at these four screens, they are all different versions or models of what? (pause)
This was a tough one, they are all versions of operating systems (windows) and how they have changed over the years.

In a small group discuss the changes that you see as the versions were upgraded (PAUSE)

- allow time for discussion and share

The main change we should have noticed was:

- Appearance: the versions transitioned from folders to icons to apps

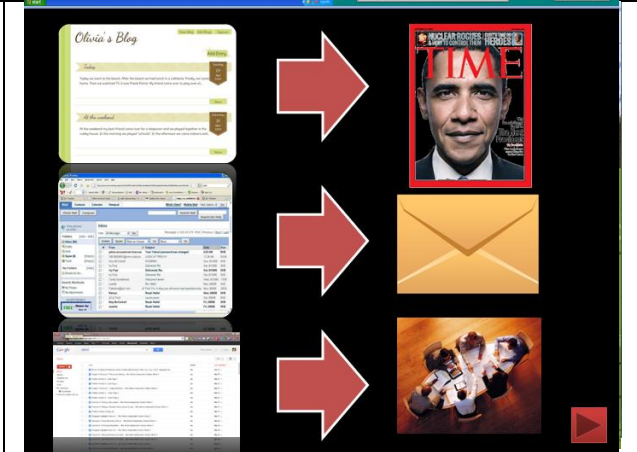


Here we have 3 upgrades:
