

There are three parts to the quiz activity, making the quiz which is essentially making a container for the quiz questions. This container has a number of settings that you must set. The second part is adding questions to the quiz which also has a number of settings. Third the question bank is a place where all your questions are stored. Over time you will have a lot of questions and as you make quizzes you can just pick and chose from the bank instead of having to create questions every time you want to set up a quiz.






Make sure editing is turned on, and select quiz from the Add an activity drop down menu



Do I really have to do all this just to make a quiz?

Moodle tries to make things as flexible as possible which results in some complexity. Many of the defaults will do just fine for a basic multiple choice quiz. Here's what you must do to make a quiz:

- 1. Name the quiz
- 2. Open the quiz
- 3. Save the quiz

Everything else is options for customizing, controlling and providing feedback which is not required








Adding a Multiple choice question®





The next sections are the choices students have to choose from by default there are 5 choices, but you can use as few or as many as you want (you can add them) The following screen shot shows only 2 but you will see 5.















Click on Save changes. You will also note the make a copy button. You can make a copy of a question make some edits and create a new question. Copying a question and editing it will be faster that creating a new question from scratch



Now you have your first question in the quiz and can add another.

Do I really have to do all this just to make a question?

Moodle tries to be everything for everyone and so that's why there are so many options for feedback etc. To create a basic multiple choice question, which is likely what most teachers want to do, all that is required is the following:


- 1. Name the question
- 2. Enter the question
- 3. Select the point value of the question(default =1)
- 4. Select if you want the choices shuffled
- 5. Enter the choices
- 6. Select 100% in the Grade field for the correct choice.
- 7. Save the question.

All the options about feedback, about some questions being more right than others etc. can be completely ignored.


About the Question Bank

Every time you create a question for a quiz it ends up in the question bank as well as in the quiz. You can reuse questions in other quizzes. You can also recategorize them, create new categories etc. The more organized your question bank is the easier it will be to make up quizzes quickly over time. In this section we'll take a look at the question bank and how it works.


First go into your class and scroll down to settings and click on the triangle next to Question




If I return to the default category and select Also show questions from sub-categories, all the questions in the Question bank appear:


Import questions from file?



Again, a lot of choices here. In the SUSD context not many teachers are going to have questions that are already in an LMS like Blackboard or WebCT so the format of interest is the GIFT format. Using the GIFT format many questions can be imported at once into the Question Bank instead of having to create them one at a time as demonstrated earlier in this document. Time will still have to be invested in making the text file to import.

The format of a multiple choice question in a text file is the following:



What denotes a right answer is the = and what denotes a wrong answer is the \sim sign. In a file like this all the spaces, brackets etc. have to be just right in order for all the questions to go in.








Exporting questions from the Question bank
